



Uniform Policy

We believe that encouraging high personal standards of our school uniform helps to give children a sense of pride in their school and a sense of belonging within the community.

Everyday Uniform

- Red sweatshirt with logo
- White polo shirt/Long sleeved shirt, blouses
- Grey or black trousers, skirt or pinafore
- Grey/black/white socks or tights
- Red and white checked summer dresses/red sunhat
- Appropriate dark coloured, flat shoes for school

Only stud earrings are to be worn in the interests of Health and Safety and children must be able to remove and replace their own earrings. Supervising adults are not allowed to help or remove children's earrings. In compliance with BAALPE, no earrings are to be worn for PE or swimming.

P.E Kit

- Bag to keep kit in
- Black shorts
- White t-shirt
- Plimsolls
- Plain black track-suit and trainers

Our uniform is deliberately simple to ensure that it is reasonably priced, easy for children to dress themselves and easily laundered. The red sweatshirt and school sunhats are available to purchase from the school office. We encourage and thank grown ups for naming all items of clothing.

- Avoiding extreme hair-cuts
- Ensuring that only stud earrings are worn in the interests of Health and Safety
